# Abstract guidelines

Structured abstracts are preferred (IMRAD format)

Word count – **300 words** 

Ethical concerns should be clearly mentioned including necessary clearances/ justification for exemptions, if any.

The submission should include a declaration that all co-authors have contributed sufficiently to the satisfy authorship criteria, and no eligible author is left out.

Mode of presentation - Oral/ Poster - the abstract reviewers will decide the category best suited for the presentation.
