

Explore Biomedical Research @ SCTIMST



Sree Chitra Tirunal Institute for Medical Sciences and Technology (SCTIMST) offers summer scholarship programs for the students belonging to Scheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribe (ST) communities who wish to get exposure to biomedical research. Students get an opportunity to interact closely with scientists, engineers and clinicians of SCTIMST who do research, development and testing of biomedical materials/devices. These programs are supported by the Science for Equity Empowerment and Development (SEED) Division, Dept. of Science and Technology, Govt. of India. The scheme will be open from the mid of March 2024 to end of May 2024. Selection will be based on the 'first come, first served' basis. Eligibility and nature of support available are given below.

WHO CAN APPLY

Category A: Students of higher secondary/intermediate levels

Duration: 4 weeks

Scholarship: Rs. 8,000 (consolidated)

Total seats : 07 (2 for SC students and 5 for ST students)

Category B: Students of 2^{nd} / 3^{rd} Year BSc (Life sciences) or 2^{nd} / 3^{rd} / 4^{th} year BTech/BE or equivalent or those who have completed the above courses.

Duration: 1 - 2 months

Scholarship: Rs. 10,000 per month (consolidated)

Total seats : 09 (only for ST students)

Category C: Students of 1^{st} / 2^{nd} year of MSc/MTech or equivalent or those who have completed the above courses.

Duration : 1 - 2 months

Scholarship: Rs. 15,000 per month (consolidated)

Total seats : 06 (only for ST students)

HOW TO APPLY

Interested candidates may download the application form given in the website (www.sctimst.ac.in), fill it out and send it to the Registrar along with copies of certificates to prove their educational qualification, community/caste, etc. on or before March 20, 2024.

Incomplete applications would be rejected.

On successful completion of the training program, certificates will be issued to students. A minimum of 80% attendance would be required for the release of the scholarship.
