<u>DST-SCTIMST Summer Scholarships for SC and ST Students at the</u> Level of +2/UG/PG

Applications are invited from the students belonging to Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe communities who wish to get exposure to biomedical research at Sree Chitra Tirunal Institute for Medical Sciences and Technology (SCTIMST), Trivandrum. Students get opportunity to interact closely with scientists, engineers and clinicians of SCTIMST who do research, development and testing of biomedical materials/devices. These programs are supported by the Science for Equity Empowerment and Development (SEED) Division, Dept. of Science and Technology, Govt. of India in a project mode. The training will be conducted in batches and is expected to start from the first week of April 2022andend by the last week of June 2022. However, the dates may change depending on the situation of COVID-19 pandemic. Selection will be based on the 'first come, first served' basis. Eligibility and nature of support available are given below:

<u>Category A</u>: Students of higher secondary / intermediate levels.

• Duration: 4 weeks

• Scholarship: Rs. 8,000 (consolidated)

• Total seats: 13 (5for SC students and 8 for ST students)

<u>Category B</u>: Students of 2nd / 3rd Year BSc (Life sciences) or 2nd / 3rd / 4th year BTech/BE or equivalent or those who have completed the above courses.

• Duration: 1-2 months

• Scholarship: Rs. 10,000 per month (consolidated)

• Total seats: 13 (5 for SC students and 8 for ST students)

<u>Category C</u>: Students of 1st / 2nd year of MSc/MTech or equivalent or those who have completed the above courses.

• Duration: 1-2 months

• Scholarship: Rs. 15,000 per month (consolidated)

• Total seats: 11(5 for SC students and 6 for ST students)

<u>How to apply</u>: Interested candidates may download the application form available in the website, fill it out and send to the Registrar along with copies of certificates to prove their educational qualification, community/caste, etc. **on or before March 31, 2022**.
